Also both have banked days so if one of them is terminated the banked days would need to be paid out. This would require an addition to the current budget of \$4,996.00. This can be added during this meeting before the final adoption on October 17th meeting.

Motion to approve adding \$4,996.00 to the Records Office budget was made by Toni Carter and seconded by Pat Heffner. Motion carried 7 ayes.
