Also present was Eric Somheil, Attorney for the Board and Vernon Maesch, Clay County Surveyor. Patricia A Foxx made a record of the following proceedings to wit:

A motion to approve July 7, 2025 minutes was made by Marty Heffner and seconded by Bryan Allender. Motion carried 5-0.

IN THE MATTER OF OLD BUSINESS

Marshall Nuckolls asked the Board members if they had heard anything regarding the Howesville Ditch. Paul Sinderson, Board Member and Vernon Maesch, County Surveyor said they had not heard anything from the Greene County or Owen County Commissioners.

IN THE MATTER OF NEW BUSINESS

Vernon Maesch, Surveyor presented the members with pictures of the Heine Ditch being clogged up. The water isn't draining properly. Kevin Schafer talked to Vernon regarding the ditch. The ditch is retaining water and is not drying out so he could drive his tractor to the property.

Paul made a motion to have Vernon to ask for 3 quotes for the culvert replacement in that area and bring them to next month's meeting, and Bryan Allender seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Heidi Kasper presented to the members that the ditch near property owner Marie Hill is flooding due to the tractors going over the culvert and smashing it down. This is in Paul's district and will look into it.

Heidi presented another issue on Perth's road of 1200 N and 300 W. The neighbor has been putting drainage tile into the ditch which is causing flooding onto the road. Bryan will look into it.

There being no other business Marty Heffner made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Marshall Nuckolls. Motion carried 5-0.
