ORDINANCE 7-2012
CLAY COUNTY CODE
CHAPTER SEVENTY-FIVE
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR LEWIS TOWNSHIP

4 - 75 - 1 PURPOSE. An Ordinance establishing a fire protection district to be known as the Lewis Township Fire Protection District and located in County of Clay, State of Indiana, as follows: an area bounded on the North by County Road 600 North; bounded on the South by County Road 1500 South; bounded on the East by County Road 350 West from 600 South to El River; and bounded on the West by County road 700 West, in order to provide greater fire protection services within the aforementioned area, and a Board of Fire trustees to execute the powers and duties granted said trustees in accordance with I.C. 36-8-11-1, et. seq.

4 - 75 - 1 DEFINITIONS. As used in this Ordinance, unless the context clearly denotes otherwise, these terms shall have the following meaning:
 "Board" refers to the Board of Fire Trustees of the Lewis Township Fire Protection District.
 "Commissioners" refers to the Board of Commissioners of Clay County, Indiana.
 "Lewis Township Fire Protection District" shall mean that territory within the boundaries outlined above in the County of Clay, State of Indiana.
 4 - 75 - 3 GENERAL PROVISIONS. The Commissioners, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-8-11-1, et seq., hereby establish the Lewis Township Fire Protection District.
 Pursuant to IC 36-8-11-12, the Commissioners shall appoint five (5) trustees to serve on the Board.
 The initial Board shall be comprised as follows:
 Marsha Riggin _____ for a term of one (1) year.
 Tony Rash _____ for a term of two (2) years.
 Pat French _____ for a term of three (3) years.
 Jeff Eccles _____ for a term of four (4) years.
 Greg Griffith _____ for a term of four (4) years.
 The terms expire on the first Monday of January of the year that the Trustees' appointments expire. As the terms expire, each new appointment is for a term of four (4) years.
 The Commissioners hereby incorporate by reference all of those provisions contained within IC 36-8-11-1 et seq.
 4 - 75 - 4 REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
 4 - 75 - 5 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. Should any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of said Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.
 4 - 75 - 6 EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Commissioners on _____ April 2, 2012.
 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval, and publication. Passed and adopted by the Clay County Board of Commissioners on this _____ day of _____, 2012.
