**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CLAY COUNTY TO JOIN THE
WABASH RIVER REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**


WHEREAS, I.C. 36-7.6-2-3 allows each county and qualified city to join with one or more other counties and or qualified cities in order to establish a development authority;


WHEREAS, Vigo, Sullivan, Knox, Parke and Vermillion counties have previously joined to form a development authority to be known as the Wabash River Regional Development Authority

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

1. Pursuant to I.C. 36-7.6-2-4, ^{Clay} ~~Parke~~ County hereby joins the Wabash River Regional Development Authority ("Authority").
2. The Authority shall be managed by a Development Board ("Board") consisting of five board members ("Board Members"). Clay County's participation in the Authority shall be subject to the adoption of a resolution by the Board authorizing the County's membership in the Authority.
3. The appointment of the Board Members shall be determined by written agreement of the executives of the members of the Authority.

This Ordinance read, considered, and adopted by the Clay County Council on June 7, 2021, after unanimous consent.


