Resolution Number 100615-01

A resolution endorsing the proposed USBR 50

Whereas bicycle tourism is a growing industry in North America, contributing \$47 billion a year to the economies of communities that provide facilities for such tourists; and

Whereas the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) has designated a corridor crossing Central Indiana to be developed as United States Bike Route 50 (USBR 50), and

Whereas Clay County, the City of Brazil, Town of Harmony, Town of Knightsville and the Adventure Cycling Association, with the cooperation of the Indiana Department of Transportation and other stakeholders, have proposed a specific route to be designated as USBR 50, a map of which is herein incorporated into this resolution by reference, and


Whereas the proposed route for USBR 50 comes through Clay County, and more specifically, through Brazil, Harmony, and Knightsville and can therefore provide a benefit to our residents and businesses, and

Whereas we have investigated the proposed route and found it to be a suitable route, and desire that the route be designated so that it can be mapped and signed, thereby promoting bicycle tourism in our area,

Therefore be it resolved that the abovementioned jurisdictions hereby express their approval and support for the development of USBR 50, and request that the appropriate officials see to it that the route is officially designated by AASHTO as soon as this can be achieved, and authorize the posting of signs within the abovementioned jurisdictions' rights-of-way identifying the route through these communities, once the official designation has been made.

The above and foregoing resolution was hereby adopted on dates during Town Council Meetings in Harmony and Knightsville and during the West Central Indiana Development District Transportation Policy Committee Meeting in Terre Haute, IN.
