**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CLAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
AND THE CITY OF BRAZIL, INDIANA RELATING TO DISPATCH SERVICES FOR THE  
CITY OF BRAZIL TO BE PROVIDED BY CLAY COUNTY, INDIANA**

This agreement is made and entered into this by and between the Clay County Board of Commissioners, located at the Courthouse c/o Auditor 609 E. National Brazil, Indiana, 47834, with the approval of the Clay County Council, and the City of Brazil, Indiana c/o Clerk – Treasurer 203 E. National Brazil, Indiana, 47834.

Whereas, emergency dispatch services for the dispatching of fire, police, and rescue services are currently being provided for the City of Brazil by Clay County in a unified facility provided and equipped by Clay County under the general supervision of the Clay County Sherriff;

Whereas, the City of Brazil and Clay County wish to renew and extend these services.

Now therefore be it agreed, by and between the City of Brazil, Indiana, hereafter referred to as “City” and Clay County, Indiana, hereafter referred to as “County” to enter into an Inter-local Cooperation Agreement, pursuant to I.C. 36-1-7 as follows:

1. The County will provide the dispatch services, including all personnel, equipment and facilities, to the City agencies as are currently provided by them in conjunction with the County’s dispatch services. The County warrants it will maintain a minimum staffing level of 12 full time employees in the unified dispatch center, subject to reasonable time to obtain replacements for any separated employees. The County further warrants that it will maintain its customary liability insurance coverage for its dispatch services.

2. For and in consideration of the acceptance of said employees and the provision of the dispatch services to the City agencies by the unified dispatch services center of the County, the City agrees to pay the county through its Treasurer the sum of \$125,000.00 in two equal installments of \$62,500.00 each to be paid within fifteen (15) days of the spring and fall tax settlement dates for the year of 2020. The Treasurer of Clay County is charged

with the duty to receive, disburse and account for all monies received by the County from the City in this undertaking.

3. The term of this agreement is one (1) year commencing January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

4. It is anticipated by the parties that this unified dispatch service will continue in future years with subsequent Interlocal Agreements with the financial obligation modified as County has passed Ordinance 2019-10 which institutes a 0.1000% tax rate for Public Safety Access Point (PSAP) which should generate approximately \$475,000 per year and fund the dispatch services, including those for the City, beginning in 2021.


5. The transfer date is January 1, 2020. The parties acknowledge that the effective date of this Interlocal Agreement shall be pursuant to I.C. 36-1-7-10 which requires this Interlocal Agreement to be;

- a. approved by the fiscal body of each party;
- b. recorded with the County Recorder;
- c. filled with the executive of the municipality and the Auditor of the county; and
- d. filed with the Auditor of the State.


6. This agreement is subject to approval of the fiscal body of the parties under I.C. 36-1-7-4.
