A RESOLUTION OF Clay County Board of Commissioners Adopting the Clay County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan (MHMP)

WHEREAS the Clay County Board of Commissioners recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Clay County; and

WHEREAS Clay County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Clay County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan January 2025, in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS Clay County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Clay County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and


WHEREAS adoption by the Clay County Board of Commissioners demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Clay County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Commissioners of Clay County, Indiana, THAT: Section 1. In accordance with (local rule for adopting resolutions), the Clay County Board of Commissioners adopts the Clay County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan of 2025. While content related to Clay County may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require Clay County to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
