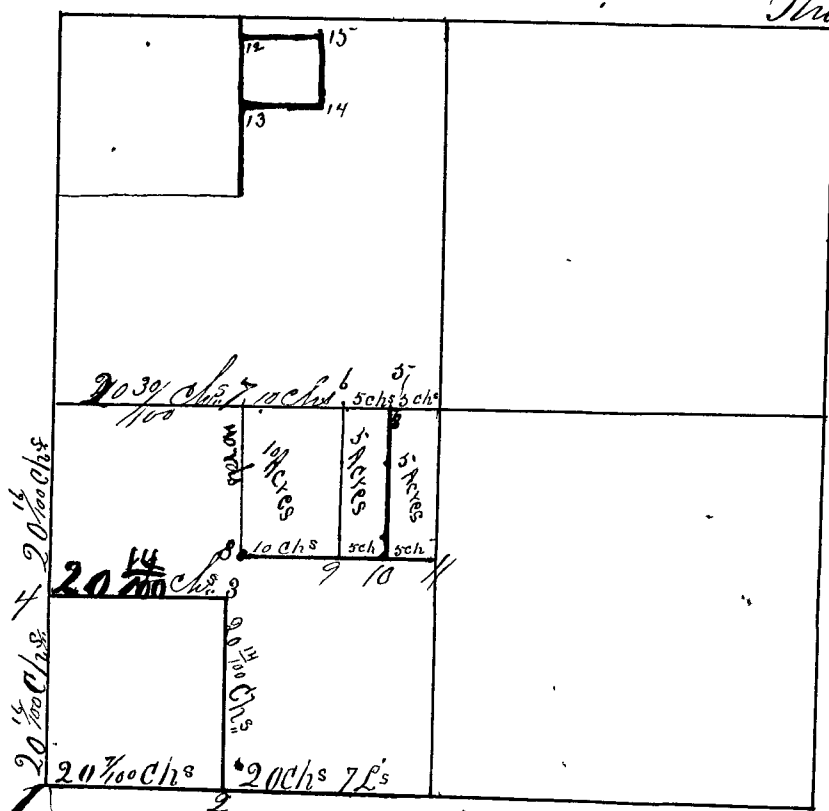


Surveyed by Thomas B Robertson Surveyor of Clay

And a Piece of stone Pump N. $67^{\circ} 30'$ E. 66 Links.

Conven N^o 2. A.S.S. Mr. 76

(m) From a S.S. 6x6 South $23^{\circ} 43' 6''$ - $28\frac{1}{2}$ Links
Two small stones North $50^{\circ} 47'$ - 41 Links

Corner N^o 3. A Flint 9x10- 20 ¹⁴/₁₀₀ chains N. from Cor. N^o 2

Frown which a Red Oak 8 in. South 175' E - 71 Links

Corner N^o 4 A Lime Stone Mt 4 N.

From which a S. S. Mer. H. N. $46^{\circ} - 29^{\frac{3}{4}}$ Links
 and a Sand Stone Mer. $\pm$ S. $20^{\circ} 15' 26''$ - $67\frac{1}{2}$ Links

Corner N^o 5. A.S.S. Mer. 20 W- 5 chains West of the center of the Section - No Wit.

Corner N^o 6. A.S.S. Mer. 40 24 = 10 chains west from the center of the Section
From which an Elm 12 S. 16° 30' E - 31 Links

Corner No 7 A Flint stone 6x10 - (No Witnesses) 20 chains 24 from the center

Corner No. 8. A Flint 20 inches long set 40 rods South from Cor. No. 7

From which a small Flint stone S²E - 18 Links

river No 9 A Flint 7x9. From which a Flint 3x8 N 84° 13' 1/2

Corner No. 10. A Flint S.S. Mr. 1. - No witnesses

No. 11 A. S. S. W. 4-Set 4.0 rods South from the center of the section

From within a Red Oak 26 in. S. 2° E. 48½ Links
