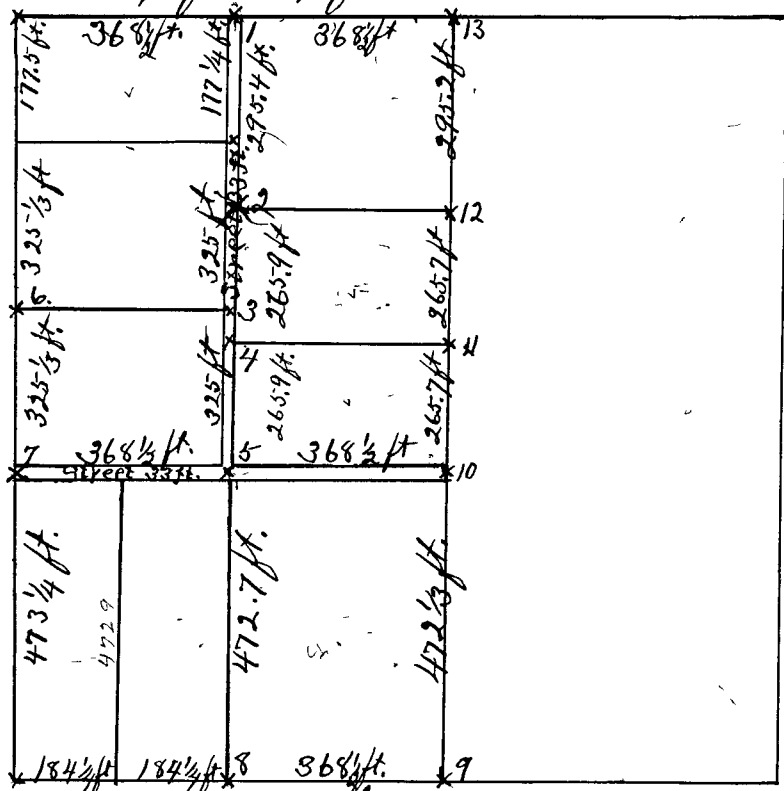


Further surveyed by L. W. Kimm after 3 weeks notice published in the Brazil Democrat, a weekly paper of general circulation published in the English language at Brazil, Clay County, Indiana. The following is a copy of said notice.



Notice of Survey
To Wm. Wake, David Bink and Andrew Lancel, non-resident. You are hereby notified that the undersigned desires to establish re-locate and perpetuate the corners and lines to the following described real estate, in Clay County, Indiana, to wit: Commencing three hundred sixty-three (363) feet east from south-west corner of the north-west quarter of the north-east quarter of Section six [6], Township twelve [12], of Range six [6], thence east three hundred sixty-three (363) feet; thence north four hundred eighty (480) feet; thence west three hundred sixty-three (363) feet; thence south four hundred eighty (480) feet to the place of beginning, containing four (4) acres more or less. Also lot number fifteen [15] in Alexander & Sarah Hadley's 1st addition to the city of Brazil, and that he will on the 11th day of December, 1902, cause L. W. Kimm, County Surveyor of Clay County, Indiana, to establish, re-locate and perpetuate all of said corner and lines and the expense of said survey to be borne equally by all persons interested.
